

# Housestaff ~ Parking, Shuttle and Transit Information

## Parking Information

### Penn Tower Parking Information

You are allowed to park in the Penn Tower garage from 4:00 p.m. to 9:00 a.m., Monday – Thursday and on the weekends from 4:00 p.m. Friday to 9:00 a.m. Monday. **Regular parking rates will apply if you are not out of the garage by 9:15 a.m.** Please bring the parking ticket with you as you will need to sign your parking ticket and have it validated at the Cashier on the Bridge Level. It will be checked against your ID card as you exit the garage. You should park in your usual lot in all other cases. At HUP, parking Lot #51 provides 24-hr access and 24-hr shuttle service.

### Penn Presbyterian Parking Information

You are allowed to park in the Presbyterian garage from 2:00 p.m. to 9:00 a.m., Monday - Friday and on the weekends from 2:00 p.m. Friday to 9:00 a.m. Monday. You must use your ID Badge to enter/exit the parking garage. **Regular parking rates will apply if you are not out of the garage by 9:00 a.m.** You should park in your usual lot in all other cases. At PPMC, parking at the Poweltown Ave Lot is available.

## Shuttle Information

## Transit Information

### Penn Transit Launches Late Night Center City Shuttle

As part of the President's new safety enhancements, Penn Transit has begun a Late Night Shuttle to Center City. The shuttle, which started on November 26<sup>th</sup> will run from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m. (on call after 3 a.m.) and provide Transit Stop to door service from campus to Center City (east to Broad Street, north to Market Street; south to South Street). This is a pilot effort which will run through the end of the academic year.

### Using Penn Transit From On-Campus

If you're on-campus, Penn Transit can take you West, North, or East of campus between 6pm and 7am. We offer both Penn Bus and Penn Shuttle services from our [14 Transit Stops and Pickup Points](#). It's easy to get a ride with Penn Transit from on-campus -- just follow the steps below.

#### If you're traveling West or East of campus:

- Go to the nearest [Transit Stop or Pickup Point](#) and wait inside if possible
- Check the [map](#) and [schedules](#) for the correct vehicle. Most Penn Bus and Penn Shuttle routes operate at 20-30 minute intervals.
- Check regularly for your Penn Transit vehicle. We operate many different buses and shuttles, so make sure you board the right one.
- Have your PennCard available to show the driver
- Tell the driver your destination upon boarding the vehicle

#### If you're traveling North of campus:

- Go to the nearest [Transit Stop or Pickup Point](#) and wait inside if possible
- Call 215-898-RIDE or 8-RIDE from a campus phone at the Transit Stop or Pickup Point
- Give your location, destination, and last name to the dispatcher
- Check regularly for your Penn Shuttle van. An **"N" or "X" will be lit up** on top of your van.
- Your Shuttle will arrive 5-20 minutes after your call. It will wait for 3 minutes at the Transit Stop or Pickup Point.

- Have your PennCard available to show to the driver
- Confirm your destination with the driver upon boarding the vehicle

From 3 a.m. to 7 a.m., a **limited** on-call service is available. Please call 215-898-RIDE or 8-RIDE from a campus phone during these hours. Waiting times may be longer.

**Penn Transit does not provide Penn Bus or Penn Shuttle services between campus locations.** If you'd like a Walking Escort, call 215-898-WALK or 8-WALK from a campus phone.

### Transit Stops and Pickup Points

Penn Transit has 14 Transit Stops and Pickup Points on-campus. A Transit Stop is a campus building where passengers can wait indoors and consult Penn Transit schedules and maps. A Pickup Point is an outdoor campus location more like a regular bus stop. You can find all of these Transit Stops and Pickup Points on the [Penn Transit Services Map](#).

**Please note:** As of Fall 2007, we have expanded our services and the number of Transit Stops and Pickup Points.

Name	Exact Location	Transit Services
Food Court	At 3409 Walnut St. just west of 34th. Wait inside the Food Court vestibule.	All Bus and Shuttle routes
David Rittenhouse Laboratories (DRL)	At 209 S. 33rd St. between Spruce and Walnut. Wait inside the lobby facing 33rd St.	All Bus and Shuttle routes
Johnson Pavilion (JP)	At the intersection of Guardian and North Service Drives, across from the Nursing Education Building. Wait inside the lobby.	West Shuttle
Quadrangle (Quad)	At the intersection of 37th and Spruce St. ("Upper Quad"). Wait in the archway entrance on the south side of Spruce.	All Bus routes, East Shuttle: board on south side of Spruce West Shuttle: board on north side of Spruce
Houston Hall	At 3417 Spruce St. between 34th and 36th, across from Gates Pavilion. Wait inside the lobby on main floor facing Spruce St.	West Shuttle
Gates Pavilion	On the south side of Spruce St. between 34th and 36th, across from Houston Hall. Wait inside the lobby facing Spruce St.	All Bus routes, East Shuttle
Pottruck Health and Fitness Center	At 3701 Walnut St., just west of 37th. Wait inside the lobby facing Walnut St..	Penn Bus West, all Shuttle routes
36th & Walnut (Pickup Point only)	The Penn Bookstore. Wait outside the main entrance on Walnut Street (not 36th Street).	All Bus and Shuttle routes
Fresh Grocer (Pickup Point only)	At 4001 Walnut St.	West Shuttle: board on Walnut St. across from Marathon Grill
Schattner Center (Pickup Point only)	At 240 S. 40th Street just south of Locust. Wait on 40th Street.	All Bus routes, East Shuttle
<b>Coming Soon:</b> Rosenthal Building (Pickup Point only)	At 3800 Spruce St., on the south side of the street, halfway between 38th and 39th.	All Bus routes, East Shuttle
