Since the fall of 2001, Dr. Arthur H. Rubenstein has served as Executive Vice President of the University of Pennsylvania for the Health System and Dean of the School of Medicine. He leads one of the premier academic health systems in the country, dedicated to the interrelated missions of medical education, biomedical research, and high-quality patient care.

Dr. Rubenstein is an accomplished physicians, diabetes researcher, and academic leader. Before coming to PENN Medicine, he was Dean and Gustave L. Levy Distinguished Professor at Mount Sinai School of Medicine in New York City, serving from 1997 to 2001. From 1967 through 1997, Dr. Rubenstein was a member of the medical faculty of the University of Chicago; from 1981 until his departure, he was also Chairman of the Department of Medicine.

Internationally recognized for his clinical expertise and groundbreaking research in diabetes, Dr. Rubenstein is a member of the Institute of Medicine of the National Academy of Sciences and a fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science. He has served on the advisory boards of several leading professional journals, including the *Annals of Internal Medicine* and the *Journal of Diabetes and Its Complications*.
