The following steps describe how to take a quiz in Knowledge Link. The examples in this job-aid are specific to PennChart instructor-led training. Other quizzes may appear differently and some options may not be available.

How to take a Quiz in Knowledge Link

- 1. Have each user log into Knowledge Link and view their Learning Plan.
- 2. Scroll to the title of the current class, click the arrow next to Enrolled, then click **Start Course**.



3. Click the assessment and/or survey link. For examples of the Assessment, proceed to the next step.



4. When the user clicks Assessment, a separate window will open, and they can click **Start**.



5. The user has several options for navigating the assessment.

- 6. If a computer freezes or a user is kicked out, the user can return and begin where they left off.
- 7. Users will be warned if they do not answer all questions before they submit. Unanswered questions will be marked incorrect.
- 8. On the last screen of the assessment, the user will see their score and a Review Quiz button.

IMPORTANT: The user must not exit this screen or they will not be able to review the questions.
