

# Spirituality & Health: A Select Bibliography of *Medline*-Indexed Articles Published in 2010

The *full, annotated* bibliography notes over 300 journal articles pertaining to spirituality & health, selected from among the more than 1,800 articles categorized under *Medline*'s subject headings of "Religion and Medicine," "Religion and Psychology," "Religion," "Spirituality," and "Pastoral Care," published during 2010.
