

Spirituality & Health: A Select Bibliography of *Medline*-Indexed Articles Published in 2011

The full, annotated bibliography notes over 394 journal articles pertaining to spirituality & health, selected from among the more than 1,700 articles categorized under *Medline's* subject headings of "Religion and Medicine," "Religion and Psychology," "Religion," "Spirituality," and "Pastoral Care," published during 2011.
